
AVA JACKET (AKA COCOA COZY) You'll need old socks, fabric glue, scissors, buttons, and fabric scraps. Cut a 4 inch section from the leg of the sock to make a wrap for a cup. Using the glue, or thread if you can sew, attach items to decorate the cozy. Slide it on a cup and you're done!

EDIBLE SNOW GLOBES For this one you'll need a pickle or mayonnaise jar with no label-this will be your globe. Fill the bottom of the jar with a layer of sugar or sprinkles then stand one or two decorated cookies up. Add gumdrops or other candy to create a scene. 
AN YOU FIND THE FIVE DIFFEREN
