- 3) COUNT HOW LONG IT WILL TAKE TO GET IT**

EXAMPLE: 5 MONTHS



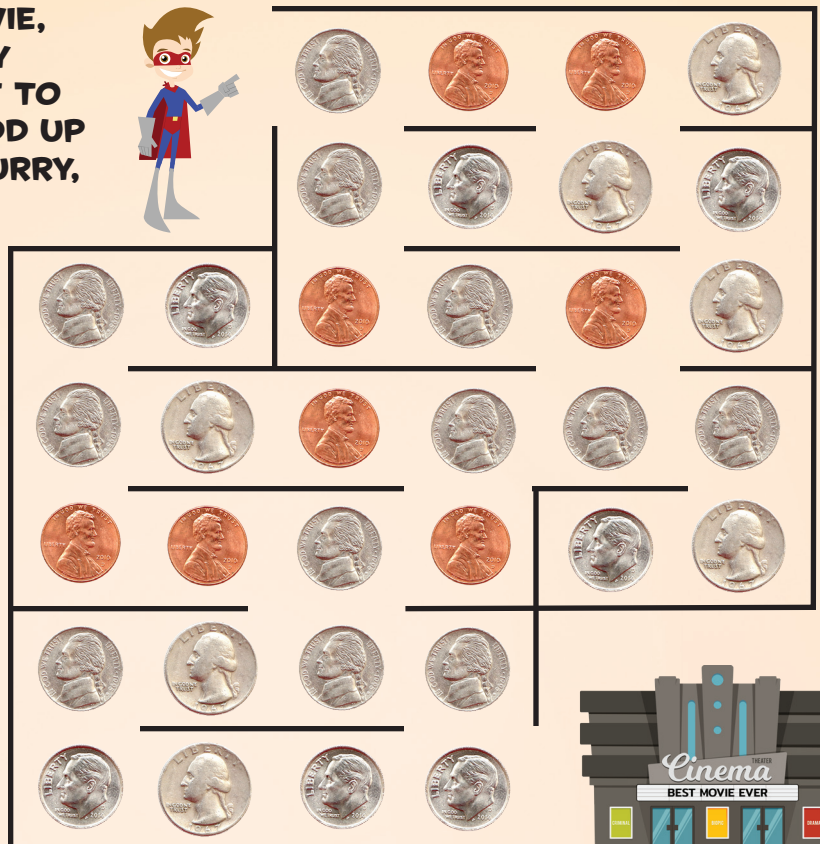
SPOT THE DIFFERENCE
