3. IN A SHOEBOX, UNDER YOUR BED.



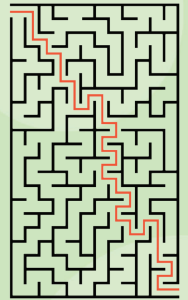

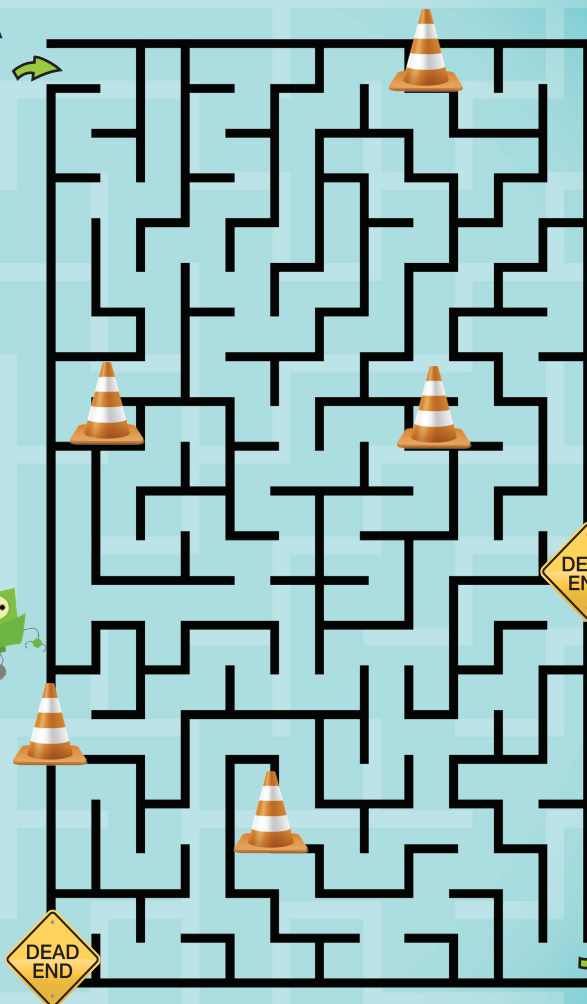
